NORTHAMPTON Nightshelter

WHO HAVE WE HELPED?

Opened in February 2017, the Northampton Nightshelter aims to provide homeless people with a safe, warm and dry environment in which they can get a good nights sleep, ready to start the next day. As well as providing emergency accommodation, the shelter also provides advice and support on issues which can contribute towards homelessness, such as employment, mental health issues and addiction, helping people to get back on their feet and engage with local services to seek more settled housing.

The night shelter opens from 9pm until 9am every night and has the capacity to provide temporary overnight accommodation for up to 20 men who have a local connection with Northampton.

Volunteers are constantly required to help with the day-to-day operation of the night shelter.

HOW HAVE WE HELPED?

On the 13th June, 4 members of staff from different Teams across the company came together to help complete a spring clean of the Nightshelter. This included, clearing the grounds, deep cleaning the shelter and organising clothing donations.
